The Hood Holder eliminates the ugly spring brackets and lets the hood lay flat on the cowl. It comes with all hardware and ready to install with pictured instructions.

The Hood Holder comes standard (sand-blasted, primed and painted gloss black with stainless steel tube). They can also be special ordered in all stainless steel or powder coated with stainless steel tubes.
